Live rurally?

**Want the WORLD'S fastest broadband?
Think the monthly fee should benefit
your local area? Then read on...**

Recently, a group of local residents looking into getting fibre broadband to our rural unconnected properties visited [B4RN](#) (Broadband for Rural North) based near Carnforth, Lancashire. They discussed getting the world's fastest broadband to the door for EVERYONE locally who would like it **within the parishes listed below.**

Yes EVERYONE in each parish! No one is too far away, no-one is left out. This would be FULL-FIBRE 1000 Mbps both download and upload, no compromises and at £30 per month on a 1 month contract for residential properties.

(BT's fastest 'available' connection is 314 Mbps at £60 per month)

B4RN is a well established **not-for-profit organisation** which helps communities in the UK build gigabit fibre broadband across rural areas to your door. All subscription costs go to extending their network to other properties which might never get a decent connection, free connections for primary schools or to local charitable projects like a new village hall roof. We have also already have secured the backing of the **Ray Wind Fund Community Interest Company (CIC)** which should help us initiate the project.

You can already have BT fibre or another provider, it makes no difference to getting connected it just gives you more choice in the future.
